Forbush Baptist Church originated as a result of Courtney Baptist Church initiative to found an "arm" of Courtney's at "Shermer's Schoolhouse in Forbush. That same day in 1873, they set aside \$2.75 for home missions to work in Forbush. First Recorded Church Meeting: September 22, 1876. First Pastor: Samuel S. May 1876-1879 First Church Building: A Log Cabin used about 14 years. First Deacons: William Spillman & D.T. Eaton March 3, 1877. First Meeting in "a new white Forbush Church" building: September 7th, 1890. First Printed Church Bulletin: July 2nd, 1944. First Newsletter: July 27th, 1972.
