A PROJECT of SAMARITAN'S PURSE

Have you thought about filling a box for an older child? You might try a theme box for ages 10-14. Here are just a few suggestions: Sewing: scissors, fabric or any color 1 or 2 yards, sewing needles with threaders, threads of different colors, pins, thimble, buttons, measuring tape, simple pattern, ribbons, etc.; Baking: Measuring cups and spoons, small loaf pan, cooking utensils, cups, bowls, water bottles, eating utensils (no knives) apron; Fishing: Fishing line, weights, bobbers, lures, hooks, plastic worms/bait, small fishing net; Tools: hammer, nails, measuring tape, screwdriver and screws, pliers, wrench, duct tapes, work gloves, utility apron or belt, string or zip ties. With your theme box, don't forget to include necessary items such as soap, washcloth, toothbrush, and school supplies. Say a little prayer as you are shopping and fill it with what God leads you to put it in. It will make it to just the right child.
