1. This song is said to have over 7,000 recorded versions. Its words were originally written by an English poet and clergyman, John Newtown, in the 1770s. It was many years until it found its melody. Truly a favorite. Complete the title: "Amazing _____"
2. This gospel favorite is an Irish poem written to the tune of an ancient Irish melody. The song includes the lyrics, "Be Thou my best thought, Thy presence, my light". Complete its title: "Be Thou My _____"
3. This song was written by a self-educated, wheelchair bound woman who was born in the mid-1800s. A childhood illness had left Jennie Bain Wilson partially paralyzed and she spent most of her life either in a wheelchair or in bed. The hymn "Hold to God's Unchanging _____" speaks of God's constant care for his followers.
4. The author of this hymn was once the elected president of a society of atheists in 19th century Edinburgh, Scotland. Later, William P. Mackay would become a Presbyterian minister and write this beautiful hymn. The song includes the lyrics, "We praise Thee, O God! For the Son of Thy love, For Jesus Who died, And is now gone above". What word completes its title? "_____ Us Again"
5. This hymn was written by Georgia native, Rev. Thomas A. Dorsey, who also wrote another song often mentioned among gospel favorites, "Peace in the Valley". What word completes its title: "Precious Lord, Take My _____"?

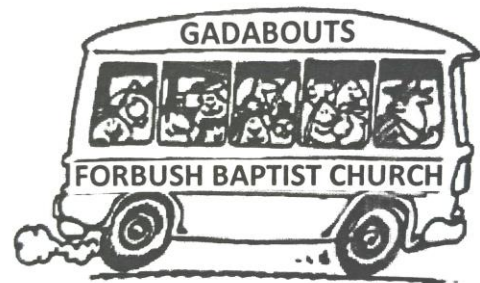
