In Star Wars Episode VI: Return of the Jedi (1983), Obi-Wan Kenobi tells a young Luke Skywalker, "Luke, you're going to find that many of the truths we cling to depend greatly on our own point of view." But is this a correct assessment in the real world?

Many people today live their lives on this premise. They make decisions based on their point of view. This is primarily because situational ethics are taught to students in our schools and colleges. This method of thought is subjective, meaning an action in one situation might be perfectly fine in another situation depending on the circumstances and context. A person must weigh the pros and cons and decide what is truth for themselves.

This is contrary to what God's Word teaches. Objective, absolute truth comes from the source of truth...Jesus Christ. Jesus said in John 14:6, "...I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." In John 17:17, Jesus prayed that all believers would be sanctified (set apart; made holy) by the truth, which is God's Word. In John 8:31-32, Jesus said, "...If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

If we study the absolute truth of God's Word, our response to any given situation can be decided beforehand. We don't have to wait until we are in a particular situation to search for truth. We will know the truth already and likely make good, life decisions.
